Training on the job in Urbino

Within the framework of WP3 from November 8 to 11 the 2nd part of the training for Albanian staff members involved in the project was run by the University of Urbino (As you remember, the 1st part was organised by UniBo in Ravenna campus).

The training focused on the **restorer's work method** and on the **figures of the restorer's collaborators** with a series of theoretical lessons on the activities of non-invasive diagnostic, chemical analysis and diagnostic instrumentation for restoration and conservation that are carried out within the restoration laboratories. Theoretical lessons were followed by practical workshop.

A study day in **Monte San Pietrangeli** aimed at sharing with the Albanian partners the experience of an open laboratory for community.

Prof. Baratin presented the session on training for Conservation and Restoration in international contexts introducing ISBAS **experience** in the establishment of a restoration course which has become part of the permanent course of the Tunisian Ministry of education, thanks to a Tempus project.

International Summer School

Preceded by a preliminary online meeting in November, the meeting for the organisation of the International Summer School took place from 12 to 13 December in Tirana.

The ISS will be held **from 2 to 14 October 2023 by the University of Shkodra Luigj Gurakuqi** in collaboration with Polytechnic University of Tirana, the Academy of
Albanological Studies and the Academy of Arts and will start with 3 days in the
archeological site of Apollonia. Students, who will be **master level or equivalent**, will
then study at the universities joining the project and will be working "hands on" in the
labs that will be equipped within REACH. This way they will be able to confront themselves
with a **very broad spectrum of activities** and will learn to handle different instruments.

A keynote conference will precede the closing ceremony.


